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AGENCY’S DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

In FY 2024-2025, the State Fiscal Accountability Authority (“SFAA” or the “Agency”) consistently worked to fulfill the Agency’s mission of providing fiscal oversight for the State of South Carolina and meeting the needs of the public sector by delivering quality, cost-effective insurance, procurement, and engineering services. In addition, SFAA leadership endeavored to identify new office and meeting space for Agency operations to relocate almost 150 employees. The accomplishments reflected in this Report demonstrate the hard work and commitment to excellence of SFAA’s staff and leadership.

Established by the Restructuring Act of 2014, Act 121, SFAA is comprised of the Insurance Reserve Fund Division and the Division of Procurement Services. The Agency is governed by a five-member Authority consisting of: the Governor, the Treasurer, the Comptroller General, the Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, and the Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee, all of whom serve ex-officio. Administrative and operational functions of the Agency are led by Executive Director Grant Gillespie.

Major Achievements During Fiscal Year 2024-2025

Division of Procurement Services (DPS)

The Division of Procurement Services (DPS) includes four operational sections — Office of State Procurement (OSP), Office of the State Engineer (OSE), Audit and Certification, and Business Operations and Strategic Planning. Some accomplishments achieved by these offices in FY 2024-2025 include the following:

1. Office of State Procurement (OSP)

A. Contract Management and Assistance

- The contract results provided by OSP in FY 2024-2025 are as follows:

- OSP provided oversight on an additional 103 delegated procurements with a total potential value of \$1.01 billion.
- The State realized contractual savings due to strategies designed to reduce the budgetary impacts for state agencies and local governments allowing for greater return on investment. The State realized the following savings through cost avoidance strategies and negotiated savings:

- OSP established new State Term Contracts with Sophos for IT security and Rubrik for cloud data management and security, while also expanding or enhancing state term contracts for Constituent

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Management Services, Temporary Medical Staffing, IT Service management and ultra low sulfur diesel fuel, to name a few.

- OSP collaborated with agencies and institutions of higher education to establish critical contracts, some of which include: SCEIS Modernization: S/4 Hana – Department of Administration; SCEIS Modernization: RISE with SAP Licensing – Department of Administration; Bridge Asset Management – SC Department of Transportation; Enterprise Application Management & Technical Support – University of South Carolina; Central Reservation System – SC Parks, Recreation, & Tourism; Family Resource Connection & Preservation Services – Department of Social Services.

B. Training and Outreach

- The Office of State Procurement implemented the SCOPES learning management system (LMS) for 550 active users and developed multiple eLearning trainings.

2. Office of State Engineer (OSE)

OSE's primary role is to assist state agencies in acquiring construction services in the manner best suited to the agency's needs. OSE is responsible to assure that all such acquisitions comply with state law. The State Engineer, as the Building Official and Deputy State Fire Marshal for construction of state buildings and facilities, is responsible for enforcement of all applicable building and fire codes. In addition, OSE serves as the administrator of the State-level Floodplain Management Program for State lands.

- In FY 2024-2025, OSE provided the following services:

- OSE assisted agencies during the design of state facilities. Several of the largest include SC State Turner Hall (\$70M), USC Williams Brice Stadium Renovations (\$300M), SC State Whittaker Library (\$30M) and CCU Health and Human Services (\$53M).
- OSE assisted agencies during the construction of state facilities. Several of the largest include the Clemson's Veterinary School (\$270 M), USC School of Medicine (\$300M), Clemson's Williamson Rd Parking Garage (\$70M), DHEC Lab (\$150M) and CCU Indoor Practice Facility (20M).

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3. Audit and Certification

Audit and Certification is responsible for conducting periodic audits of each agency's procurement operations to determine compliance with the South Carolina Procurement Code and regulations.

Audit Status: Conducted audits and completed reports for 6 agencies and completed reports for 2 agencies that were not submitted due to statutory reorganization. Started audits of three certified agencies.

4. SCPro eProcurement

South Carolina Procurement (SCPro) is the new online procurement platform for sourcing competitive solicitations, contracting, supplier management and procurement activities for the state of Carolina. Once fully implemented, it will be available to all agencies, suppliers and other government entities through the state's South Carolina Enterprise Information System (SCEIS) and integrations to other ERP systems. SCPro replaces the current SCEIS Supplier Relationship Management (SRM) tool and will include a virtual marketplace that consists of online supplier catalogs which state agencies, local governments and political subdivisions can access to purchase goods and services. In FY 2024-2025, SFAA continued managing the implementation of SCPro in collaboration with the SC Department of Administration and SCEIS.

Insurance Reserve Fund Division (IRF)

The Insurance Reserve Fund (IRF) is a self-insurance mechanism operated by the State of South Carolina providing insurance to governmental entities at the lowest possible cost. All State agencies must purchase their insurance through the IRF and participation is optional for local governments. The Mission of the IRF is to provide property and liability insurance products that meet the needs of its governmental customers in a financially secure and responsible manner. The Insurance Reserve Fund currently insures more than \$40 billion in property values for State and local government entities. Some accomplishments achieved by the IRF in FY 2024-2025 include the following:

1. Effectively managed claims and losses relating to catastrophic events

- For the tenth consecutive year, IRF managed claims and losses relating to a catastrophe loss. Prior planning and implementation of the IRF catastrophic loss ("CAT") Plan allowed for the successful allocation of resources in handling 118 Hurricane Helene claims with an incurred loss of \$8.1 million.
- Handled 68 claims that equaled \$8.5 million for 5 pre-existing Mini Catastrophes.

2. Renewed Property Reinsurance Coverage

- IRF successfully purchased reinsurance for a capacity level to protect for a 100-year storm and maintained the existing occurrence self-inured retention (SIR). This renewal of reinsurance coverage was, in part, due to:
 - Relationships built through face-to-face annual meetings in South Carolina with London, Bermuda, and Domestic reinsurance markets.
 - Continued improvement in the quantity and quality of data points collected and reported in IRF Statement of Values;

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- The property reinsurance markets' positive view of the IRF claims handling of past catastrophic events and consistent reserving practices.

3. Implemented IRF policy changes and new deductibles with all policies issued on or after July 1, 2024.

- Policy changes included defining Electronic Data and added Cyber Incident Exclusion and revising the Electronic Data Processing Equipment Policy.
- New deductibles were applied to the property damage on the Tort Policy, the standard deductible on the Property Policies (Building and Personal Property, Business Interruption, Electronic Data Processing Equipment, Builders Risk), standard deductible on Inland Marine and standard deductible on Automobile Comprehensive and Collision Policy.

4. Provided training and outreach to enhance State's Risk Management Practices

- Hosted Medical Professional Risk Management seminars directed to insured hospitals on the following topics: "AI Documentation in Emergency Medicine, Medical/Legal Issues with disruptive patients" in Charleston, SC and "Legislative updates and Current Trends in SC Court Cases MUSC Just Culture Program" in Columbia, SC.
- Hosted Boiler meeting for IRF insureds with Chief Boiler Inspector at LLR to provide specialized insight into boiler safety requirements and strategies to follow to clear boiler violations.
- Hosted annual meetings for specialty lines insurance of Ocean Marine insurance, Aviation insurance, and UAV/Drone insurance. These meetings connected the specialty line brokers with the insureds to discuss terms of renewal, state of the market, unique issues of coverage, and educational opportunities made available through the broker.
- Hosted Risk Management Water Damage Meeting with select insureds introducing and explaining controls to reduce water damage losses based upon review of property trend data which indicates that in recent years, apart from natural catastrophe losses, interior originating water damage has been the single greatest cause of property loss for the IRF.
- Conducted specialized seminar for 100 participants at DSN to explain Business Interruption Coverage, Tort Liability, Pre-paid legal, Medical Professional Liability, and data processing to facilitate a greater understanding of insurance provided and underwriting information needed.

5. Successfully solicited and issued contracts for essential coverage and services

- Procured broker services to assess and advise the State on its Ocean Marine insurance needs and to provide ocean marine insurance to those insureds with oceangoing vessels and cargo.
- Procured a contract for Building Valuation Services and collection of Insurance Data through a Request for Proposals. This contract sustains a strong insurance to value program; strengthens the

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data used to successfully obtain property reinsurance; and minimizes disputes related to value in the event of a property loss.

- Procured a contract to establish a vendor to provide the Insurance Reserve Fund (IRF) with 100% reinsurance on the automobile liability policies issued by the IRF.

Agency Wide

1. Management of activity related to the five-member Authority

A. Authority Meeting and Agenda Process

The Authority held seven meetings during the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year. Prior to each meeting, SFAA staff and the Executive Director held agenda review meetings with internal and external staff and others as needed to develop the meeting agenda and address any matters prior to the meeting.

B. Coordination with Authority Members

The Agency responded promptly to our members' offices about pending and potential agenda items, such as procurement audits, major leases, composite bank accounts, and management and assignment of bond counsel.

2. Administration of the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund (SCORF) Board

A. SCORF Board Meetings and Opioid Fund Distribution

- Managed the administration of the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund Board. The SCORF Board held five in person meetings, two virtual meetings and provided virtual viewing capabilities of meetings for members of the public.
- The SCORF Board distributed \$24,980,753.11 to 51 counties, towns and cities that requested funds to help combat the opioid epidemic. The Board also awarded \$6,356,529.33 in discretionary funds to fourteen entities proposing evidence-based and novel approaches to addressing opioid misuse in South Carolina.

B. Implementation of new awards management system and new website for SCORF Board

- In conjunction with SFAA IT, redesigned and modernized the SCORF Board website to allow for increased transparency, including the ability to include additional reporting metrics and timely information and updates.
- Purchased and implemented a SaaS grant management system which creates a new mechanism for funding applications to be received, reviewed and scored while also tracking awards by abatement strategy allowing for the generation of reports about all facets of the SCORF Fund.

3. Assistance to Agency Head Salary Commission

- SFAA continued to provide staffing support and administrative functions for the Agency Head Salary Commission which primarily administers the agency head performance process.

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- In accordance with Code Section 8-11-165, SFAA conducted a salary and fringe benefit study which was adopted and implemented by the Agency Head Salary Commission in June 2024.
- Prepared agenda items and supporting materials for the Commissions meetings. Based on market trends and statewide salary data, made recommendations to the Commission regarding agency heads hiring salaries, salary increases, performance evaluations and salary ranges.
- In coordination with a third-party consultant and the Department of Administration, the Agency Head Salary Commission began work to revamp the performance management process for all agency heads and higher education/technical college presidents.

4. Strengthened operations through process improvements, cost-saving measures, and compliance with applicable laws.

- Due to the ending of the current lease for SFAA, SFAA leadership worked to identify and lease new office and meeting space for the Agency. Leadership secured new space and parking for the Agency and worked with an architect and construction team to reconfigure the space to comply with established State Space Standards. The Agency will be relocating in the fall of 2025.
- As part of the transition to SCPro, SFAA IT developed a new application database for the Office of State Procurement to track procurement vendors, solicitations, contract and sales to replace a legacy system.

5. Implemented Strategic Planning Initiatives

A. Conducted Regular Management Meetings

- The Senior Management team met on a bi-weekly basis to determine progress toward Agency goals and objectives. These meetings focus on challenges from all agency divisions and offices, major project updates, and legislative matters that impact our delivery of services to our customers and the citizens of the State of South Carolina.
- Held the annual Management Retreat which focused on leadership strategies for managing changes and applying effective leadership principles.

Risk Assessment and Mitigation Strategies

A. Provide innovative, cost effective and proactive acquisition services (Strategic Plan Goal No. 5)

Potential Most Negative Impact if this goal is not accomplished:

The State should expect to pay more for goods and services, as there would be no coordinated program dedicated to lowering costs by leveraging the State's collective buying power. Without such a program, statewide contracts would not be awarded which would result in increased administrative costs. The lack of any centralized procurement office would result in: a) increased cost to vendors due to an uncoordinated approach to procurement across multiple agencies; b) increased risk of poor performance and contract claims due to a lack of statewide training and support efforts; and c) decreased transparency and accountability across the State's acquisition system.

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Outside Help to Mitigate Impact Request and options for General Assembly: assistance from procurement trade groups, interstate networks and professional consulting firms. Continued support and resources for a robust and automated procurement system.

- B. Provide cost-effective property and liability insurance and administration of the Insurance Reserve Fund (Strategic Plan Goal No. 2)

Potential Most Negative Impact if this goal is not accomplished:

If the IRF did not operate, the State should expect to pay more to insure against its risks, with some agencies likely having difficulty obtaining coverage from a private insurance carrier because of poor loss experience and the nature of the risks involved, such as law enforcement, corrections and transportation. Also, absent the stability of IRF rates, the State should expect significant swings in premium costs due to normal cyclical changes in the commercial insurance market.

Outside Help to Mitigate Impact Request and options for General Assembly: IRF undergoes regular audits and actuarial evaluations. Risks to these programs could be avoided through continued oversight, proper funding and support for existing improvement efforts.

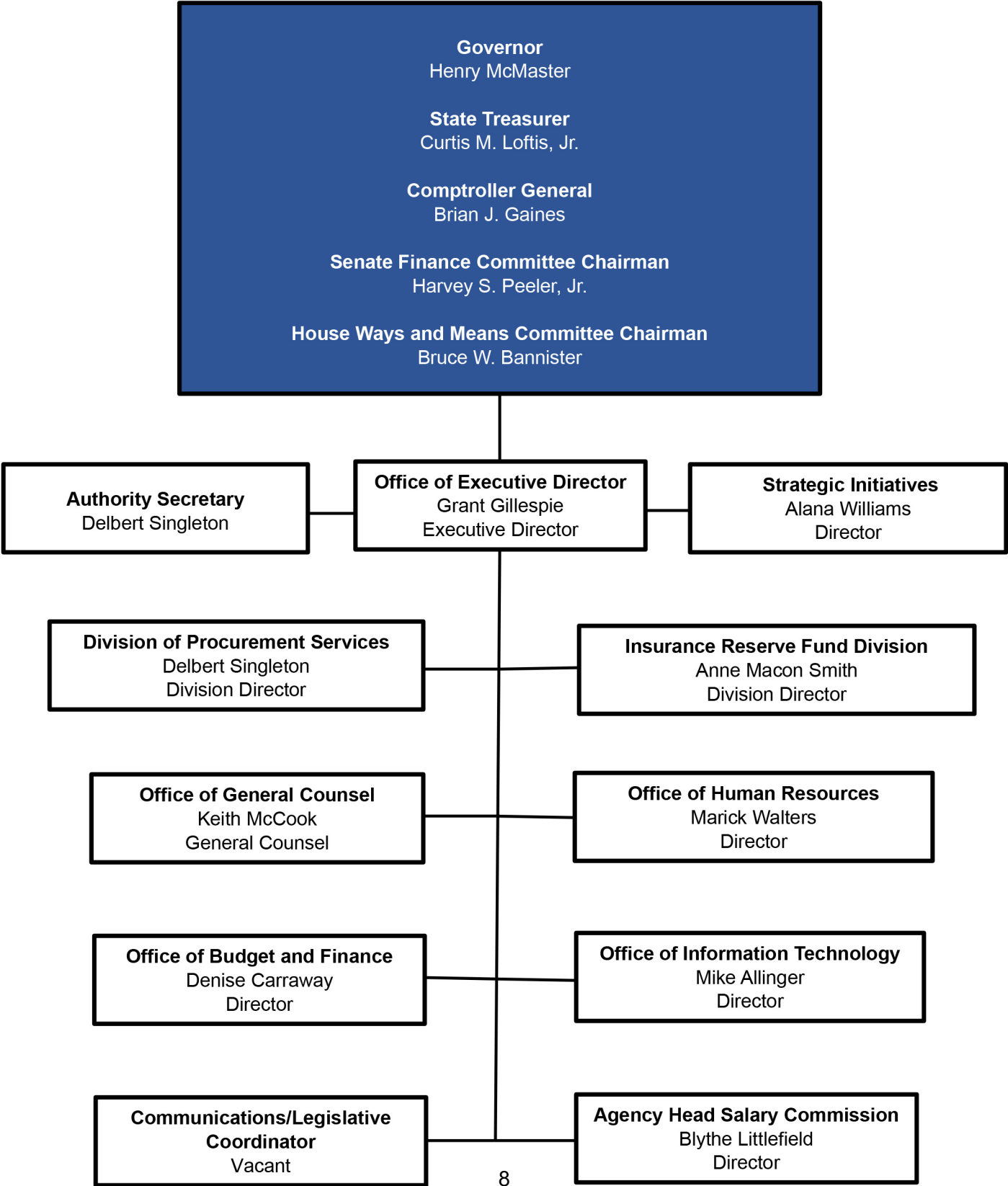
